Effective 1 July 2007 CW5 Anderson assumed duties as the Center for Army Leadership Warrant Officer Leader Development Officer, the Chairman of the Senior Warrant Officer Advisory Council and the Senior Warrant Officer Advisor to the Combined Arms Center Commanding General at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. CW5 Anderson entered the United States Army in 1984. Prior to his current assignment, he served as the Senior Warrant Officer for the Aviation Personnel Proponency Directorate at Fort Rucker, Alabama; Battalion Aviation Maintenance Officer for the 194<sup>th</sup> Maintenance Battalion and Maintenance Activity Chief for a contract civilian facility in the Republic of Korea; AC/RC Unit Trainer with the 278<sup>th</sup> ACR in Tennessee; Production Control Officer for the 4/159<sup>th</sup> Aviation Support Battalion at Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Shops Platoon Leader and Tech Supply Officer for E Company, 502<sup>nd</sup> Aviation Regiment in Aviano, Italy; Shops, Tech Supply and Maintenance Officer for E Troop, 2/4 Cavalry at Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia; Medical Evacuation Pilot for 159<sup>th</sup> Medical Company in Darmstadt, Germany; and AH-1 Helicopter Repairer at 609<sup>th</sup> Maintenance Company at Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia.

CW5 Anderson received his warrant officer appointment in 1988 after attendance at the Warrant Officer Candidate School and the Initial Entry Rotary Wing Course at Fort Rucker, Alabama. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Behavioral Psychology from Armstrong State College in 1994 and received his Master of Science in Communications with an emphasis in Journalism from the University of Tennessee in 2003. He is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Senior Staff Course, the Advanced Force Management Course, the Warrant Officer Staff Course, the Warrant Officer Advanced Course, the Aviation Maintenance Officer Course, UH-60 Qualification Course, Warrant Officer Basic Course and the Initial Entry Rotary Wing Course.

CW5 Anderson is the recipient of the Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters (OLC), the Army Commendation Medal with three OLC, the Army Achievement Medal with six OLC, the Army Good Conduct Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Korea Defense Service Medal, the Global War on Terrorism service ribbon, the Armed Forces Service Ribbon, and the NATO Medal. He currently resides on Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
